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Rules & Regulations - All Rules To Be Strictly Adhered To - No Exceptions

- 1.) Only members of the USBC who are certified for the current season prior to the date the player participates are eligible to compete in this tournament. You must pay a Local Association dues, if not already certified in Summit County.
- 2.) Tournament will be handicapped as follows: Team – 90% of 880 scratch.
- 3.) All bowlers must use their highest certified USBC average of 21 games or more from the previous season, including summer. If there is no certified USBC average from the previous season, bowlers will use their highest certified USBC average of 21 games or more from the current season at time of bowling (bring league standing sheet). All others must use 220 scratch. USBC Rule 319a pertaining to 10 pin increase in current average does not apply.
- 4.) USBC Rule 319e. All bowlers shall submit themselves for re-rating and shall be re-rated before entering a classified or handicap tournament, if applicable.
- 5.) Multiple participation is permitted. In order to place more than once in the prize list for position standings, team players must change as follows:
Team Event: A team is made up of two women and two men bowlers. At least two players in the lineup must be different.
- 6.) Report all substitutions to the Tournament Manager when signing in.
- 7.) In case of injury, disability, or emergency, after a game has started, a substitute will be permitted if one is available. Handicap shall be prorated according to averages of both bowlers involved. If no substitute is available, the disabled bowler's actual score will count for the frames bowled.
- 8.) Entries will be scheduled according to requests if possible and in the order received. The schedule will not be changed by the tournament manager except for emergency.
- 9.) No refunds of entry fees paid.
- 10.) Prizes will be based on highest total pins with handicap. Actual Champions will be recognized. Handicap and Actual Champions will be offered one free admission per bowler to the Tri-County Hall of Fame Banquet.
- 11.) Prize fees returned 100%. Prizes will be based on a minimum of not less than one prize for every ten (10) entries.
- 12.) Entry fees must be paid in full to guarantee a spot in the tournament.
- 13.) USBC Rule 17B.1 "Engaging in improper tactics or conduct in connection with the game of bowling including, but not limited to, physical and verbal abuse toward other persons." Membership may be suspended or denied to anyone who is involved in a violation of this rule.
- 14.) Lanes will be assigned by the tournament manager. Check-in time is 30 minutes prior to bowling.
- 15.) Protests and appeals must be in writing stating the grounds for protest or appeal. A protest involving eligibility or playing rules must be filed with tournament management within 72 hours of the infraction, or prior to tournament prizes being paid, whichever occurs first. The decision of the tournament management shall be final, unless a written appeal is filed with the local association or USBC Headquarters within 10 days of notification of tournament management's decision.
- 16.) Tournament play will begin at the stated times on the front of the entry form.
- 17.) Entrants may enter OPTIONAL SCRATCH EVENT by completing the entry form and submitting the Optional Scratch fund fee with entry. To be eligible for Optional Scratch Event teams must enter the Handicap Tournament event and will use scratch scores bowled in the Handicap Event. A separate prize list will be established for the Optional Scratch Event. Optional Scratch Event entrants may cash in each Optional Scratch Event up to the number of times entered.

THE ENTRANTS WHOSE NAMES APPEAR HEREON OR THEIR AUTHORIZED REPLACEMENTS HEREBY AGREE THAT THE SUMMIT COUNTY USBC, ITS OFFICERS AND AGENTS SHALL BE LIABLE ONLY TO THE EXTENT OF RETURNING ENTRY FEES IF AND WHEN THESE ENTRANTS SHALL BE PREVENTED FROM BOWLING ANY EVENT IN THE TOURNAMENT THROUGH PREMATURE TERMINATION OF THE TOURNAMENT WHICH MAY BE BROUGHT ABOUT BY WAR, NATIONAL EMERGENCY OR EMERGENCIES, OR CASES RELATING THERETO OR RESULTING THEREFROM FIRES, STRIKES, LOCKOUTS, LABOR DIFFICULTIES OR OTHER CAUSES BEYOND CONTROL OF THE SUMMIT COUNTY USBC.

All Items not covered by these rules will be referred to USBC rules. **WEATHER: The Summit County USBC reserves the right to cancel tournament or scheduled shifts due to inclement weather conditions.**
