Rules & Regulations - All Rules To Be Strictly Adhered To - No Exceptions

- 1.) Only female members of the Summit County USBC who are certified for the current season 30 days prior to the date the player participates are eligible to compete in this tournament.
- 2.) This will be a handicap singles tournament consisting of three (3) games. Total pins for three games, including handicap of 90% of 220 scratch, will determine winner in each class. Entrants may only compete once in this tournament.
- 3.) All bowlers must use their highest certified Summit County USBC average of 21 games or more from the previous season, including summer. If there is no certified SC USBC average from the previous season, bowlers will use their highest SC USBC average of 21 games from the current season at time of bowling (bring league standing sheet). All others must use 220 scratch. USBC Rule 319a pertaining to 10 pin increase in current average does not apply.
- 4.) USBC Rule 316e. All bowlers shall submit themselves for re-rating and shall be re-rated before entering a classified or handicap tournament, if applicable.
- 5.) Multiple participation is not permitted. Singles Event: Only one single event will be permitted.
- 6.) Entrants must be at least 55 years of age at the time of participation. **PROOF OF AGE MAY BE REQUESTED AT CHECK IN.**
- 7.) WHEN BOWLING IN THE SUMMIT COUNTY USBC WOMEN'S TOURNAMENT, SCORES BOWLED IN FIRST EVENT SHALL QUALIFY AS SENIOR TOURNAMENT SCORES UNLESS NOT SCHEDULED TO BOWL IN THE SUMMIT COUNTY USBC WOMEN'S TOURNAMENT.
- 8.) In the event of a tie for first place in any division, Co-Champions will be declared for this tournament.
- 9.) Each division winner will receive a paid entry into the 2012 Ohio State USBC WBA Senior Tournament.
- 10.) Any bowler arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count in the frame then being bowled.
- 11.) Prize fees returned 100%.
- 12.) Entry fees must be paid in full to guarantee a spot in the tournament.
- 13.) USBC Rule 17b.1 "Engaging in improper tactics or conduct in connection with the game of bowling including, but not limited to, physical and verbal abuse toward other person." Membership may be suspended or denied to anyone who is involved in a violation of this rule.
- 14.) Lanes will be assigned by tournament manager. Check-in time is 30 minutes prior to bowling.
- 15.) Protests and appeals must be in writing stating the grounds for protest or appeal. A protest involving eligibility of playing rules must be filled with tournament management within 72 hours of the infraction, or prior to tournament prizes being paid, whichever occurs first. The decision of the tournament management shall be final, unless a written appeal is filed with the local association or USBC Headquarters within 10 days of notification of tournament management decision.
- 16.) Women's Tournament play will begin at the stated times on the front of the entry form.

THE ENTRANTS WHOSE NAMES APPEAR HEREON OR THEIR AUTHORIZED REPLACEMENTS HEREBY AGREE THAT THE SUMMIT COUNTY USBC, ITS OFFICERS AND AGENTS SHALL BE LIABLE ONLY TO THE EXTENT OF RETURNING ENTRY FEES IF AND WHEN THESE ENTRANTS SHALL BE PREVENTED FROM BOWLING ANY EVENT IN THE TOURNAMENT THROUGH PREMATURE TERMINATION OF THE TOURNAMENT WHICH MAY BE BROUGHT ABOUT BY WAR, NATIONAL EMERGENCY OR EMERGENCIES, OR CASES RELATING THERETO OR RESULTING THEREFROM FIRES, STRIKES, LOCKOUTS, LABOR DIFFICULTIES OR OTHER CAUSES BEYOND CONTROL OF THE SUMMIT COUNTY USBC.

WEATHER: Summit County USBC reserves the right to cancel tournament or scheduled shifts due to inclement weather conditions. All items not covered by these rules will be referred to USBC rules.
